ORDER

The Commission, on its own motion, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. An in person hearing in these matters shall be held on Tuesday, August 17, 2021, at 9 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time, and continue on Wednesday, August 18, 2021, in the Richard Raff Hearing Room at the offices of the Public Service Commission at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.

2. Telephonic public comments shall be accepted at the beginning of the hearing. Instructions for telephonic and written public comment shall be posted on the PSC website, psc.ky.gov, prior to the beginning of the hearing

3. Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) and Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E) shall each give notice of the hearing in compliance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(b). In addition, the notice of hearing shall include the following statement: “This hearing will be streamed live and may be viewed on the PSC website, psc.ky.gov.,” and “Public comments may be made at the beginning of the hearing. Those wishing to make oral public comments may do so by following the instructions listed on the PSC website, psc.ky.gov.” At the time the notice is mailed or publication is requested, KU and LG&E shall forward a duplicate of the notice and request to the Commission.

4. Pursuant to KRS 278.360 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(9), a digital video transcript shall be made of the hearing.
