ORDER

This matter arises upon the motion of Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government (Louisville Metro), filed December 14, 2020, for full intervention. It appears to the Commission that such intervention is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings. The Commission, being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that Louisville Metro should be granted full rights of a party in this proceeding. The Commission directs Louisville Metro to the Commission's March 16, 2020 and March 24, 2020 Orders in Case No. 2020-00085<sup>1</sup> regarding filings with the Commission. The Commission expects the original documents to be filed with the Commission within 30 days of the lifting of the current state of emergency.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The motion of Louisville Metro to intervene is granted.
2. Louisville Metro shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.
3. Louisville Metro shall comply with all provisions of the Commission's regulations, 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, related to the service and electronic filing of documents.
4. Louisville Metro shall adhere to the procedural schedule set forth in the Commission's December 9, 2020 Order and as amended by subsequent Orders.
5. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(9), within seven days of entry of this Order, Louisville Metro shall file a written statement with the Commission that:
  - a. Certifies that it, or its agent, possesses the facilities to receive electronic transmissions; and
  - b. Sets forth the electronic mail address to which all electronic notices and messages related to this proceeding should be served.
6. Within ten days of the date of this Order, Louisville Metro shall file a copy with the Commission any agreement regarding Louisville Metro's joint participation with any other party in this matter or with any party in Case No. 2020-00349.<sup>2</sup>


