ORDER

The matter is before the Commission upon a joint motion filed by Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) and Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E) in their respective cases requesting to schedule an informal conference beginning on Thursday, April 15, 2021, at 9:30 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, and continuing through Friday, April 16, 2021. KU and LG&E propose the informal conference to be held at the offices of Stoll Keenon Ogden PLLC at 500 West Jefferson Street, Suite 2000, Louisville, Kentucky. The motion states that KU and LG&E have prepared one floor of the firm's office to accommodate the parties

to these two cases to attend in-person, virtually, or both. The motion also outlines the specifics of how the informal conference will be conducted both in-person and virtually. Lastly, KU and LG&E state that the purpose of the informal conference is to discuss the issues and for the possibility of resolving some or all of the issues by stipulation and recommendation.

Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that KU and LG&E have presented good cause for the scheduling of the informal conference as requested.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the joint motion of KU and LG&E requesting the scheduling of an informal conference for purposes of settlement negotiations as described above is granted.

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
