On June 10, 2021, New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC, d/b/a AT&T Mobility (AT&T Mobility) filed a motion requesting to withdraw its application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) for construction of a wireless communications facility in Marshall County, Kentucky that was filed on November 2, 2020.

Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds AT&T Mobility 's application should be withdrawn. The Commission further finds this matter should be closed and removed from the Commission's docket.

1. AT&T Mobility's motion to withdraw its application for a CPCN is granted.
2. This matter is hereby closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
