ORDER

On November 25, 2020, Burkesville Gas Company, Inc. (Burkesville) filed its Gas Cost Recovery (GCR) rate report for rates with a proposed effective date of December 28, 2020. Burkesville's previous GCR rate was approved in Case No. 2020-00281.¹

After reviewing the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

- 1. Burkesville's report includes revised rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in gas costs.
- 2. Burkesville's report sets out an Expected Gas Cost (EGC) of \$8.5053 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$.3985 per Mcf from the previous EGC of \$8.1068 per Mcf.
 - 3. Burkesville's report sets out no Refund Adjustment.
- 4. Burkesville's report sets out a current quarter Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) of \$.0152 per Mcf. In calculating its total ACA, Burkesville erroneously included an incorrect amount of (\$.7130) per Mcf for the Previous Quarter ACA. The correct Previous Quarter ACA is (\$.0713) per Mcf as approved in Case No. 2020-00281.² Correcting this

produces a total ACA of \$.5598, which is a decrease of \$.1956 per Mcf from the previous total ACA of \$.7554 per Mcf.

- 5. Burkesville's corrected GCR rate is \$9.0651 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$.2029 per Mcf from the previous GCR rate of \$8.8622 per Mcf.
- 6. The rates set forth in Appendix A to this Order are fair, just and reasonable and should be approved for service rendered by Burkesville on and after December 28, 2020.
- 7. Should Burkesville purchase sustainable natural gas from a renewable source during the reporting period of any future GCR reports then the supplier, cost, and amount must be documented in its cover letter to the Commission.
- 8. The Commission finds that Burkesville should file responses to the requests for information set forth in Appendix B to this Order when it files its next GCR report for rates effective for the April 2021 billing cycle.
- a. Pursuant to the Commission's Orders in Case No. 2020-00085,³ issued March 16, 2020, and March 24, 2020, Burkesville SHALL NOT FILE the original paper copy of all requested information at this time, but rather shall file original paper copies within 30 days of the lifting of the current state of emergency. All responses in paper medium shall be appropriately bound, tabbed, and indexed. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

- b. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or an association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.
- C. Burkesville shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect.
- d. For any request to which Burkesville fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Burkesville shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.
- Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request.
- f. When filing a paper containing personal information Burkesville shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that the personal information cannot be read.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates proposed by Burkesville are denied.

- 2. The rates set forth in Appendix A to this Order are approved for service rendered on and after December 28, 2020.
- 3. Within 20 days of the date of entry of this Order, Burkesville shall file with this Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets setting out the rates approved herein and reflecting that they were approved pursuant to this Order.
- 4. Burkesville shall file responses to the requests for information set forth in Appendix B to this Order when it files its next GCR report for rates effective for the April 2021 billing cycle.
 - 5. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
