COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND POST-HEARING REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
TO COLUMBIA GAS OF KENTUCKY, INC.

Columbia Kentucky (Columbia Kentucky), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due no later than August 18, 2023. The Commission directs Columbia Kentucky to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the

response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Columbia Kentucky shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Columbia Kentucky obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which Columbia Kentucky fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Columbia Kentucky shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, Columbia Kentucky shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. With regard to Items 5 and 6 previously included in Commission Staff's Post Hearing Request for Information issued July 31, 2023:

a. Provide the Choice volumes corresponding to the page showing relative percentages of Residential and Commercial customer volumes on the pie graph entitled Total Volumes Purchased from Marketers by Participating Customer in each of Columbia Kentucky's Annual Customer Choice Reports filed for the five years 2018

through 2023. For ease of reference, this chart is provided on page 11 of Columbia Kentucky's May 30, 2023 annual report.

b. For each of the Choice total annual volumes provided in a. above, indicate whether and where those specific volumes are included in the PBR component calculations (provided in Columbia Kentucky's annual Gas Cost Adjustment filings, most recently in Schedule 6 of Case No. 2023-00141) for each of the same years. Further, discuss each specific PBR component calculation and how it would be incrementally impacted by a shift of Choice volumes to commodity sales volumes if Choice customers no longer purchased their gas from marketers.

c. Provide calculations for each PBR component showing PBR savings for each of the years indicated (five years ending 2023) if Choice customers had bought their gas from Columbia Kentucky instead of marketers.

d. Provide total annual throughput on Columbia Kentucky's system for 2018 through 2023, as of this date.
