ORDER

On July 28, 2022, the Commission issued an Order directing Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District (Jessamine-South Elkhorn District) to provide renote to its customers of the rates contained in the Appendix to that order. The Appendix to that Order contained both an error in the rate table regarding a meter size and a typographical error. The rate table contained rates for a “1 1/2-Inch Meter” that should have been for a “2-Inch Meter.” Additionally, the language in the rate table used the word “Galoons” instead of the appropriate word “Gallons.” The Commission finds that the July 28, 2022 Order should be amended to reflect the correct meter size and correct the typographical error.

Finding that the July 28, 2022 Order shall be amended, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS, *nunc pro tunc*, that:

1. The Appendix is stricken and is replaced with the Appendix attached to this order.
2. All other provisions of the Commission’s July 28, 2022 Order that are not in conflict with the terms of this Order shall remain in effect.

APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 2022-00050 DATED AUG 05 2022

On February 25, 2022, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) accepted for filing Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District’s (Jessamine-South Elkhorn District) application requesting to increase its revenue from water sales by \$178,342, an approximate increase of 7.10 percent. On July 19, 2022, Commission Staff determined Jessamine-South Elkhorn District would require an increase of \$214,944 or 8.56 percent in revenue from water sales. Jessamine-South Elkhorn District requests the PSC approve its recommended revenue requirements and that Jessamine-South Elkhorn District be allowed to implement the revised rates as follows:

The proposed rates shall not become effective until the Public Service Commission has issued an Order approving these rates. The rates will increase the monthly bill of a typical residential customer using 6,000 gallons a month from \$59.64 to \$64.64, an increase of \$5.00 or approximately 8.38 percent.
