ORDER

On November 1, 2022, Kentuckians for the Commonwealth, Kentucky Solar Energy Society, and Mountain Association (collectively Joint Intervenors) filed a motion requesting leave to file a corrected version of a report prepared by Energy Futures Group that Joint Intervenors filed on October 11, 2022, with their Initial Comment on East Kentucky Power Company’s (EKPC) 2022 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP). In support of their motion, Joint Intervenors stated that errors in the report needed to be corrected to improve clarity and correct a figure pertaining to the Cooper Station capacity factor, which EKPC had indicated was incorrect. Joint Intervenors provided a redacted, corrected version of the report with minor revisions and included a redlined version of the corrected report. Joint Intervenors noted that their report contains information that EKPC requested remain confidential and that if their motion is granted, they will confidentially file an unredacted version of the corrected report. No party objected or otherwise responded to Joint Intervenors’ motion.

On June 1, 2022, the Commission entered an Order in this matter requiring Intervenor comments, if any, to be filed by October 3, 2022. On July 28, 2022, following a request by EKPC to extend a deadline, the Commission amended the procedural

schedule to allow, among other things, Intervenor comments to be filed until October 11, 2022. The June 1, 2022 Order in this matter stated that motions for extensions of time would only be granted upon a showing of good cause.

Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the motion should be granted. The Commission finds that correction is necessary to ensure that the record is accurate.¹ The Commission also finds that allowing the correction at this point will not prejudice any party because the corrections are minor, the Joint Intervenors provided a redlined version of the report that should allow parties to easily identify the revisions, and the hearing in this matter has not occurred such that EKPC will have an opportunity to address the revisions. Thus, the Commission finds that there is good cause for extending the deadline for Intervenor comments to allow Joint Intervenors to file their corrected report.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Joint Intervenors are granted leave to file the corrected report prepared by Energy Futures Group in response to EKPC's 2022 IRP.
2. The redacted version of the corrected report shall be deemed filed as of the date of this Order.
3. Joint Intervenors shall confidentially file an unredacted version of the corrected report, both with and without redlines showing any revisions, within three business days of the date of service of this Order.
