SITING BOARD STAFF'S POST-HEARING REQUEST FOR INFORMATION  
TO SEBREE SOLAR II, LLC

Sebree Solar II, LLC (Sebree Solar II), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on September 5, 2023. The Siting Board directs Sebree Solar II to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085<sup>1</sup> regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the

person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Sebree Solar II shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Sebree Solar II obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which Sebree Solar II fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Sebree Solar II shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, Sebree Solar II shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Provide the entity that executed the crossing agreements with Texas Gas Transmission, LLC.
2. Provide the entity that will employ the individuals responsible for compliance with a certificate of construction during construction and operation of the project if granted.

3. Provide the Midcontinent System Operator, Inc. (MISO) Definitive Planning Phase 1 Study.

4. Provide the job titles and duties of the employees that will be hired for the operations phase of the project. Also include in the response the expected salary for these positions.

5. Provide the salary of people employed by NextEra Energy, Inc., or its direct or indirect subsidiaries, for operational phase jobs. Include the location of the project, the size of the project, and the number of operational employees for each project.

6. Provide the entire corporate structure, or membership interests, of Sebree Solar II.

7. Provide the entire corporate structure of NextEra Energy, Inc.

8. Provide the entities that were included as entities with an ownership interest Sebree Solar II in the Application, Exhibit 11.

9. Provide the native grasses and plants that will be included in the vegetative planning for groundcover in the project area.

10. Provide the vegetation management plan that will be implemented during operations for invasive species that are not planted by Sebree Solar II as groundcover.

11. Refer to the Application, Exhibit 12, Site Assessment Report (SAR), Attachment A, Exhibit 8, page 4, Table 1. Explain the notation under the table related to the Total Decommissioning Costs.

12. Refer to the Application, Exhibit 12, SAR, Attachment A, Exhibit 8, page 4. Explain what actions Sebree Solar II will take to alert the Henderson City-County Planning Commission that the project has ceased operations.
