ORDER

This matter is before the Siting Board upon a motion that was filed on June 29, 2026, by Sebree Solar II, LLC (Sebree Solar II) requesting an extension of time to submit its responses to certain requests included in Siting Board Staff’s Request for Information issued on June 22, 2026. The Request for Information directed responses to be filed on June 30, 2026.

On June 29, 2026, Sebree Solar II filed a motion requesting a 14-day extension to file responses to Siting Board Staff’s Request for Information.¹ Sebree Solar II stated that stated that the personnel at NextEra Energy LLC (NEER) who are responsible for responding to requests for information regarding financial transactions and equity investments are unavailable due to previously scheduled vacations and the upcoming holiday.²


