Notice is hereby given that the City of Jackson proposes to increase its rate for wholesale water service effective July 1, 2022. Documentation will be filed with the Kentucky Public Service Commission on May 31, 2022, to increase the rate as follows:

	Current Rate	New Rate	\$ Change	% Change
Water Rate per 1,000 gallons	\$3.92	\$4.04	\$0.12	3%

The purposed effective date is July 1, 2022. Water flowing through the meter(s) before the effective date will be charged the current rate. Water flowing through the meter(s) on and after the effective date will be charged at the proposed new rate.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by the City of Jackson but the Public Service Commission may order rates to be changed that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.

The filing may also be examined at the offices of the Public Service Commission located at 211 Sower Boulevard in Frankfort, Kentucky, Monday through Friday from 8:00am to 4:30pm or through the PSC website at http://psc.ky.gov.

Comments regarding the filing may be submitted to the PSC through its website or by mail to Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602.

A person may submit a timely written request for intervention to the PSC, P.O. Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602, establishing the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party. The Public Service Commission may take final action on the filing if a written request for intervention is not received within 30-days of the date notice was given.
