PSC

LG&E has denied gas service connections to Mt. Washington for 2 years. No new customers can connect to Natural Gas, even though there are gas mains installed by developers and paid by Developers to LG&E for the mains. LG&E keeps <u>lying</u> about the need to have an extension to Shepherdsville before Mt. Washington will be allowed gas connections.

How is an extension main going to help Mt. Washington when the transmission line where the extension main to Shepherdsville is connecting (south of Mt. Washington), already serves and comes through Mt. Washington from the Calvary Supply System. LG&E has stated under oath that there will be enough gas from the Calvary line to supply Shepherdsville and Mt. Washington when the line to Shepherdsville is built. If there is enough natural gas after the extension is built, and no additional gas is going to be pumped into the Calvary System, how is there not enough natural gas in that main NOW? Nothing has been said that additional gas will be needed, just a main to Shepherdsville has to be built.

If LG&E does not have sufficient natural gas to supply Mt. Washington NOW, then how can they have sufficient gas after the extension is constructed to Shepherdsville, when they will be tapping the same main that currently serves and comes through the center of Mt. Washington.

None of this makes sense. Either LG&E has not performed as a utility, by proper planning and purchasing enough natural gas for the future needs of the citizens of Kentucky or they are lying about the available gas that is available to Mt. Washington NOW, and has been for 2 years...

Thank you for contacting the Commission regarding LG&E. We contacted LG&E and received the following response:

Background:

At this time, LG&E is continuing to defer new gas service requests in this area because of gas system issues related to the Bullitt County Pipeline not being completed. The relevant area in Mt. Washington is served from a medium pressure system that is connected to the single high pressure distribution pipeline gas system that is at full capacity (and which the Bullitt County pipeline is designed to supplement). Because of the interrelatedness of these two pipelines, LG&E has been deferring service to Mt. Washington since 2019.

Resolution:

Tara contacted Mr. Stout to discuss his complaint. Tara advised Mr. Stout he was entered into a few contracts with LG&E for pro-rata gas main extensions, starting in 2003. His contracts have all expired. Those contracts provided that, in the event additional new customers use that extension over a 10-year period, LG&E would refund a portion of Mr. Stout's payment. They do not guarantee the availability of gas service during or after the 10-year refund period.

LG&E is continuing to evaluate options to make service available in this area in the future. If/when the availability status changes, we will communicate this to the area at that time. Mr. Stout has requested to speak to someone in the gas department. Tara has sent over his request for someone to contact him.

State the nature of your concern: LG&E has stopped suppling natural gas to Mt. Washington commercial and residential customers. Their excuse is the Bernheim Forest lawsuit. The proposed extension runs from a transmission line just south of Mt. Washington west to 1-65. This new main does not increase volume of gas for Mt. Washington . Therefore, If gas is currently available to feed the new extension, then there is no reason that Mt. Washington does not have gas available currently. We have commercial properties with gas mains that we have paid LG&E to install and now LG&E has refused to supply gas. There is no new gas quantiles being increased to this proposed line, that cannot be supplied now. Mt. Washington is being held hostage in order to get through Berheim. Kenny Stout 1-26-2022
