Based upon Mr. Fryman's August 5, 2022 update withdrawing the complaint and Nicholas District's Notice of Satisfaction, the Commission finds this matter has been satisfied and that the complaint should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The complaint filed by Barry Lane Fryman against Nicholas District is dismissed.
2. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket as the complaint has been satisfied.
