ORDER

A hearing in the above-styled matter was held on May 9, 2023, through May 11, 2023. At the conclusion of the witness testimony, Commission Staff's counsel requested to file post-hearing data requests and multiple parties expressed interest in filing post-hearing briefs on issues raised at the hearing.

Based upon the number of parties in the case, the Commission indicated its desire for simultaneous briefs and simultaneous reply briefs. Each party in interest may file a brief. To ensure an orderly process, a party must raise all issues in their respective initial post-hearing brief. In the post-hearing response briefs, a party may not raise any new issues and may only respond to issues raised in initial post-hearing briefs.

From the bench, the Commission ruled upon Duke Energy Kentucky's (Duke Kentucky) May 5, 2023 motion to file corrected rebuttal testimony of several witnesses. Duke Kentucky noted the corrections were discovered during witness preparation for the formal hearing. The Commission finds good cause to grant the motion because the parties and the Commission had the opportunity to question the witnesses during the

formal hearing on issues raised in the corrected testimony. The Commission also finds Duke Kentucky and any other party that noted corrections to testimony or responses to requests for information should file notices with those corrections within one week of the conclusion of the formal hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Duke Kentucky's May 5, 2023 motion to file corrections to witness testimony is granted.

2. Corrected testimony of any witness shall be filed on or before May 15, 2023.

3. Post-hearing requests for information, if any, shall be filed on or before May 16, 2023.

4. Responses to post-hearing requests for information shall be filed on or before May 26, 2023.

5. All parties shall file a memorandum brief, should they choose to do so, in support of their respective post-hearing position on or before June 9, 2023.

6. All parties shall file any post-hearing response briefs, should they choose to do so, addressing only issues raised in initial briefs on or before June 19, 2023.

7. This case shall stand submitted for a decision by the Commission effective 12:01 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time, June 20, 2023.

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
