To The Kentucky Public Service Commission:

We're writing to provide recommendations regarding case# 2022-00424.

* We ask the Commission to order LG&E-KU ("the Companies") to immediately increase Demand Side Management (DSM) programs and reengage the Demand Side Management (DSM) Advisory Group of stakeholders. The Companies must conduct the analysis of potential DSM programs using readily available economic and race data by census tract in order to create the most effective DSM programs offerings with the most low- and fixed-income customer benefit.

* We ask the Commission to retire the coal-fired generation units and to deny the Companies request to build two new gas-fueled generation plants. The need was not identified during the Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) process or in their final plan, and the Companies have not reasonably considered less-risky alternatives.

*We ask the Commission to approve the proposed solar and battery storage projects.

*We ask the Commission to increase Distributed Energy Resources (DER) to minimize the need for creating new energy capacity and target benefits for affordable rates for low-and fixed-income households.

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To The Kentucky Public Service Commission:

I am writing to provide recommendations regarding case# 2022-00424.

I encourage you to require LG&E-KU to re-engage the Demand Side Management Advisory Group of stakeholders and to call into accountability LG&E-KU's **lack of such programs and lack of such thinking in their documents projecting the company's operations in the near future.** LG&E-KU spin their projections **unsupported** by studies incorporating the significant advancements of renewals such as solar, wind, and geothermal. Being a monopoly seems to have withered their research and development (R&D) investments. This is not a successful business model.

I am asking the Commission to retire the coal-fired generation units and to deny LG&E-KU's (1900's mindset and move into 2000's mindset) request to build two new gas-fueled generation plants.

I am asking the Commission to approve the proposed solar and battery storage projects.

I am asking also, that you **halt** the closing of the offices to serve the public. Closing these offices demonstrates how convenience for the customer is low priority to LG&E-KU.

In addition, I am asking the Commission to increase Distributed Energy Resources to minimize the need for creating new energy capacity and target benefits for affordable rates for low- and fixed-income households to even
