RE: Informal Conference of November 13, 2024

Pursuant to an Order issued on November 1, 2024, an informal conference (IC) was conducted on November 13, 2024. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the IC was to discuss the proposed settlement between the parties. Christen Blend, with Kentucky Power, outlined the highlights of the proposed settlement in the case. There was discussion about how the terms, in particular, the credit to customers would be executed and the timing of that credit.
