Application

Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power” or the “Company”) moves the Public Service Commission of Kentucky (the “Commission”) pursuant to KRS 278.020(2), 807 KAR 5:001, Section 15, and all other applicable statutes and regulations for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing Kentucky Power to:

(a) Retire the existing 8.2 mile 46kV transmission line between the existing Stone Substation in Pike County, Kentucky and the Sprigg Substation in Mingo County, West Virginia. Kentucky Power will only perform the work related to the 6.5 mile portion of the transmission line located in the Commonwealth;

(b) Retire the existing Belfry 46kV Substation in Pike County, Kentucky;

(c) Retire the 0.75 mile Turkey Creek 69kV Tap transmission line;

(d) Construct the Orinoco 69kV Substation in Pike County, Kentucky; and

(e) Construct approximately 6.5 miles of 69kV transmission line in Pike County, Kentucky between the existing New Camp 69kV Substation and the existing Stone 69kV Substation via the new Orinoco 69kV Substation;

(f) Perform related work, including certain substation equipment retirements, at the Stone 69kV Substation and the New Camp 69kV Substation;
