INTRA-AGENCY MEMORANDUM

KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

RE: Informal Conference of June 27, 2023

Pursuant to Commission Order issued on June 23, 2023, an informal conference (IC) was conducted on June 27, 2023. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the IC was to discuss whether the 2022 data versus the 2023 data should be provided in the response to the first Data Request. Mayor Slone discussed that the City of Louisa had gotten a new accounting system which City staff did not fully understand and resulted in their utilizing the wrong data column in reports. Mayor Slone then proceeded to explain why there was a preference of using the 2023 data due to increase in materials cost, especially chemicals. There was a general discussion of the increase in costs of various expenses. There was also a brief discussion about the types of reports that could be provided. Mayor Slone stated that the last increase for Big Sandy was in 2015. Mr. Abshire discussed the possibility of coming in more frequently for an increase in the wholesale rates to Big Sandy. There was also a discussion whether the 2023 data could be provided by June 30, 2023. Mr. Helton inquired into an additional extension of time until July 31, 2023. Ms. Hall explained that a motion would need to be filed requesting another extension.

There being no further discussion, the IC was then adjourned.
