COMMISSION STAFF'S POST-HEARING REQUEST FOR INFORMATION  
TO TAYLOR COUNTY RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION

Taylor County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (Taylor RECC), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due no later than November 9, 2023. The Commission directs Taylor RECC to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085<sup>1</sup> regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the

response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Taylor RECC shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Taylor RECC obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which Taylor RECC fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Taylor RECC shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, Taylor RECC shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Provide cost justification sheets for each nonrecurring charge contained in Taylor RECC's tariff.

2. Provide Taylor RECC's annual reliability metrics for 2008 through September 2023. Include the System Average Interruption Duration Index (SAIDI), System Average Interruption Frequency Index (SAIFI), Customer Average Interruption Frequency Index (CAIDI), Customer Average Interruption Duration Index (CAIDI), and

Customer Minutes of Interruption. Separately show outages caused by right of way (ROW) vegetation.

3. Provide the board of directors meeting minutes from July 19, 2023, to present.

4. Provide any feasibility studies done for the potential of new headquarters for Taylor RECC.

5. Provide purchase price and any paperwork related to mileage or usage for the vehicle used by Jeffrey Williams.

6. Reference Corrected Exhibit 3, Schedule B2.

a. Provide the initial date Taylor RECC drew on its CoBank short-term line of credit as well as the dates the line of credit was renewed since 1995.

b. Provide the most recent renewal agreement as well as the dates of all additional draws on the account in the past three years.

c. Provide the current interest rate for the line of credit.

d. Provide the dates and amounts of all payments made on the line of credit for the last seven years.

7. Provide the agreements, including terms and any mileage or usage restrictions, of each of the leases listed in the auditor's report provided in Application, Exhibit PW-2, page 15, note 7.

8. Refer to Schedule 1(a), Account 931 and Account 589.

a. Provide an explanation for two accounts designated "rent" and a detailed description of what is included in each account.

b. Explain why the spreadsheet notes a 0 percent amount of change for Account 931 for year 2021 to 2022.
