On March 3, 2023, our house electrical system and appliances were back fed high voltage from the overhead main transmission line. This resulted in the main panel bus bar and all GFI breakers being damaged. All GFI outlets have been destroyed as well as some lighting fixtures, and the majority of all major appliances including the fornace. This is the FOURTH time in the past seven (7) years that this has occurred. On the 3rd incident, Kentucky Utilities determined that they had not installed proper spacing between the upper and lower wires and supposedly corrected the situation. After the 4th major loss, we have no reason to believe that issue has been corrected. It has created a possible safety issue in our home.
