ORDER

On December 13, 2023, the Commission issued an Order that required, *inter alia*, parties to this case to file statements either requesting a hearing, or to have the case submitted for a decision based on the record, no later than April 11, 2024. As of the April 11, 2024, deadline all parties have filed responsive statements.<sup>1</sup> No party requested a hearing.

As part of their statements, Kentucky Solar Energy Society and Mountain Association (collectively, Joint Intervenors), and the Kentucky Solar Industries Association, Inc. (KYSEIA) requested a briefing schedule.<sup>2</sup> The applicants, Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E) and Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) (collectively,

LG&E/KU), and the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by the Office of Rate Intervention (Attorney General) were silent regarding establishing a briefing schedule in this case. The Commission finds that simultaneous briefs and response briefs are necessary to complete the record in this matter. However, the Commission also notes that a party is not required to file a brief. Upon the filing of the response briefs, the case will be submitted to the Commission for a decision based on the record.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. All parties shall file a memorandum brief, should they choose to do so, in support of their respective position on or before May 24, 2024.
2. All Parties shall file any response briefs, should they choose to do so, addressing only those issues raised in the initial briefs, on or before June 14, 2024.
3. This case shall stand submitted for a decision by the Commission effective 12:01 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time, June 15, 2024.
