Dear Governor Beshear:

As the Chairman of the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC), I also serve as the Chairman of the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting (Siting Board). Therefore, it is my duty to inform you that, on March 1, 2024, the Siting Board received an Notice of Intent from Mantle Rock Solar, LLC requesting a certificate to construct an approximately 65-megawatt merchant electric solar generation facility in Kentucky.

The five permanent members of the Siting Board are the Chairman, Vice Chairman, and Commissioner of the PSC; the Secretary of the Energy and Environment Cabinet (or her designee);¹ and the Secretary of the Economic Development Cabinet (or his designee).²

Mantle Rock Solar, LLC (“Mantle Rock”) hereby submits for filing this Notice of Intent to file an application for a Certificate of Construction for an approximately 65 MW solar facility (“Mantle Rock Project”).

- b. The proposed construction is briefly described as follows:

The facility will consist of approximately 562 acres of solar panels and associated racking (approximately 65 MW), inverters, battery storage, and a project substation.

- c. The proposed Mantle Rock Project will be located in the vicinity of the intersection of Maxfield and Carrsville Road. The latitude and longitude are 36°31'51.47"N, 88°23'24.85"W. The Mantle Rock Project is not located within the limits of any city.
- d. There is no planning or zoning commission with jurisdiction over the site.
- e. Because there is no planning or zoning commission with jurisdiction over the site, there are no local setbacks set forth by County ordinance.
- f. There are no residential neighborhoods, schools, hospitals, or nursing home facilities within 2,000 feet of the Mantle Rock Project, and therefore, the applicant will not need to request a deviation from the setback requirements found in KRS 278.704(2).
