<u>O R D E R</u>

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission established this case on August 2, 2024, to review and evaluate the operation of the Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC) of Kentucky Power Company (Kentucky Power) for the six months that ended on April 30, 2023. As part of this review, Kentucky Power responded to two requests for information.

A review of Kentucky Power's monthly FAC filings shows that the fuel cost billed for the six months under review ranged from a low of \$0.00724 per kWh in January of 2023 to a high of \$0.07725 per kWh in December 2022 with a six-month average of \$0.04242 per kWh.

Having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds no evidence of improper calculation or application of Kentucky Power's FAC charges or improper fuel procurement practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The charges and credits billed by Kentucky Power through its FAC from November 1, 2022, through April 30, 2023, are approved.

2. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
