RE: Informal Conference of July 29, 2025

Pursuant to a Staff Notice issued on July 15, 2025, an informal conference (IC) was conducted on July 29, 2025. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the IC was to discuss Rattlesnake Ridge Water District's (Rattlesnake Ridge District) Qualified Infrastructure Improvement Plan (QIIP). Commission Staff informed Rattlesnake Ridge District that, upon review of the QIIP filed on July 21, 2025, further information will be necessary for Staff to make a recommendation to the Commission and a request for information will be issued in attempt to obtain particular details regarding the proposed QIIP.

Rattlesnake Ridge District did confirm that it has sought alternate funding via grants for some of the projects that are listed as proposed future projects in the QIIP. Rattlesnake Ridge District will provide a distinction between those projects and the projects it proposes to use surcharge funds for, in response to Staff's upcoming request for information.

Staff further discussed that the Commission will ultimately issue an Order accepting or rejecting the QIIP. Staff also cautioned Rattlesnake Ridge District that a request for expenditure must be made in writing to the Commission prior to any surcharge funds being used. Staff also cautioned Rattlesnake Ridge District to comply with all deadlines moving forward in the case.

There being no further discussion, the IC was then adjourned.
