<u>ORDER</u>

On July 8, 2024, Muhlenberg County Water District No. 3 (Muhlenberg District No. 3) applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment (PWA) procedure set forth in KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068.

LEGAL STANDARD

In accordance with KRS 278.015, when a wholesale supplier selling water to a water district increases its rates, the water district has the authority to increase its rate commensurate with the wholesale supplier. The water district must file, within the statutory and regulatory deadlines, a copy of the notice from the wholesale supplier showing the increase in the wholesale rate, and a statement of the volume of purchased water used to calculate the rate adjustment. The Commission shall approve the filing by order after the above documents are filed.

DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS

Muhlenberg District No. 3 purchases water from Central City Municipal Water & Sewer (Central City). Central City notified Muhlenberg District No. 3 that its wholesale rate would increase from \$3.81 per 1,000 gallons to \$4.57 per 1,000 gallons, effective

July 1, 2024.¹ Muhlenberg District No. 3 proposes to increase the water rates to its customers effective July 1, 2024, to reflect the increased cost of purchased water from Central City.

Prior to filing this PWA, Muhlenberg District No. 3 also had an Alternative Rate Filing (ARF) application, Case No. 2023-00400, pending before the Commission. Despite its pending ARF application, Muhlenberg District No. 3 properly calculated its proposed PWA rates² based on the rates approved in its prior rate case, Case No 2022-00231.³ After the PWA application was filed on July 8, 2024, new rates were approved in Muhlenberg District No. 3's ARF case and those rates were effective August 1, 2024.⁴ Therefore, the rates as proposed by Muhlenberg District No. 3 in its application should be denied. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are calculated based on the current rates approved in Case No. 2023-00400 on August 1, 2024.

<u>Unaccounted-for Water Loss</u>

Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 6(3), states that for ratemaking purposes a utility's unaccounted-for water loss shall not exceed 15 percent of the total water produced and purchased, excluding water consumed by a utility in its own operations. In its 2021 Annual Report filed with the Commission, Muhlenberg District

No. 3 reported a water loss of 18.2354 percent.⁵ In its 2022 Annual Report filed with the Commission, Muhlenberg District No. 3 reported a water loss of 19.1359 percent.⁶ In its 2023 Annual Report filed with the Commission, Muhlenberg District No. 3 reported a water loss of 15.5462 percent.⁷ Muhlenberg District No. 3's three-year water loss average is 17.6392.⁸ The approximate cost of Muhlenberg District No. 3's annual total water loss based on the 3-year average is \$137,973.71.⁹

The Commission is placing greater emphasis on monitoring utilities that consistently exceed the 15 percent unaccounted-for water loss threshold. The Commission strongly encourages Muhlenberg District No. 3 to pursue reasonable actions to reduce its unaccounted-for water loss. Failure by Muhlenberg District No. 3 to make significant progress towards reducing unaccounted-for water loss may cause the Commission to pursue additional action with the utility.

Financial Condition and Rates

As noted above, Muhlenberg District No. 3 recently sought an alternative rate adjustment in Case No. 2023-00400, using a test year of 2022.¹⁰ The operating ratio method was applied, and the Commission determined Muhlenberg District No. 3's Overall

Revenue Requirement to be \$1,625,953, a revenue increase of \$239,003, or 17.87 percent.¹¹ The August 1, 2024 Order increased the monthly bill of a typical residential customer using 4,000 gallons from \$42.15 to \$49.63, an increase of \$7.48, or 17.75 percent.¹²

Purchased Water Adjustment Factor

In its PWA application, Muhlenberg District No. 3 proposed a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.95 per 1,000 gallons. During the 12 months ended April 30, 2024, Muhlenberg District No. 3 purchased 171,159,600 gallons of water from Central City and sold 137,201,500 gallons of water to its customers. The increase in the cost of purchased water from Central City is \$130,081.29, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.95 per 1,000 gallons as shown in Appendix A.

The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.95 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A, and the rates set forth in Appendix B to this Order are fair, just and reasonable and should be approved for water service rendered by Muhlenberg District No. 3 on and after August 1, 2024, because the rates are supported by evidence of the increase in rates from Muhlenberg District No. 3's wholesale water supplier and the volume of purchased water used to calculate the rates in accordance with KRS 278.015.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.95 per 1,000 gallons is approved.
 - 2. The rates proposed by Muhlenberg District No. 3 are denied.

- 3. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are approved for water service rendered by Muhlenberg District No. 3 on and after August 1, 2024.
- 4. Within 20 days of the date of service of this Order, Muhlenberg District No. 3 shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
 - 5. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
