# <u>ORDER</u>

On September 25, 2024, Kentucky Power Company (Kentucky Power) filed a motion for an extension of time of a week to respond to a certain requests for information from the Attorney General.<sup>1</sup> Kentucky Power also filed a motion requesting deviations from the filing requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(4)(b).<sup>2</sup> As grounds for this request, Kentucky Power stated that the size of the information, 4.8 GB, to be provided was too large to be emailed from Kentucky Power to counsel or uploaded from counsel

to the Commission using the electronic filing system.<sup>3</sup> Kentucky Power indicated that the Attorney General had no objection to this request.<sup>4</sup> Kentucky Power has made arrangements to provide flash drives with the information for intervenors and for filing with the Commission. According to the motion, given the large volume of the information and the number of different files included in the attachment to be filed, including but not limited to PDF and Excel, it was not practical nor reasonable for Kentucky Power to reformat and individually label the documents and pages.<sup>5</sup>

The Commission finds good cause to grant Kentucky Power's motion for an extension of time of a week, until October 2, 2024, to file certain responses to the Attorney General's First Request. The Commission notes that it is only a short extension and based on the data size of the response, this is a reasonable request. As to the request to deviate from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(4)(b), the Commission recognizes that the contents of the response make impracticable for Kentucky Power to reformat and ensure compliance with the regulation. As such, the Commission finds that Kentucky Power has demonstrated good cause to be allowed to both file the response on a USB flash drive and not in the specific format required by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(4)(b).

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

Kentucky Power's motion for an extension of time of a week, October 2,
2024, to file certain responses is granted.
