Dear Judge Noble:

As the Chair of the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC), I also serve as the Chair of the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting (Siting Board). Therefore, it is my duty to inform you that on August 7, 2024, the Siting Board received a Notice of Intent from STMO Bn, LLC (Starfire) requesting certificates to construct an approximately 210-megawatt merchant electric solar generation facility and an associated transmission line, both of which will be located in Knott, Breathitt and Perry counties, Kentucky.

The five permanent members of the Siting Board are the Chairman, Vice Chairman, and Commissioner of the PSC; the Secretary of the Energy and Environment Cabinet (or her designee);¹ and the Secretary of the Economic Development Cabinet (or his designee).²

In addition to the permanent members of the Siting Board, there will be two ad hoc members that will be chosen for this matter. Because the facility subject to Siting Board approval is proposed to be in more than one county, in this instance the proposed solar facility is to be located in Knott, Breathitt and Perry counties, KRS 278.702(1)(d)(2) requires that one of the ad hoc members "shall be the county judge/executive of a county in which the facility is proposed to be located, to be chosen by majority vote of the county judge/executives of the counties in which the facility is proposed to be located" KRS 278.702(1)(d)(2) also requires the selection of the judge/executive by a majority vote within 30 days after the filing of Starfire's application. Otherwise, the Governor will directly
