ORDER

On August 13, 2025, Twin Diamond, LLC (Twin Diamond) filed a motion, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13, and KRS 61.878(1)(m)(1), requesting that the Commission grant confidential treatment for indefinite period for certain portions of its response to Commission Staff's First Request for Information. According to Twin Diamond, this response contain the latitude and longitude of certain water distribution infrastructure and Exhibit 1-5, which consists of a map that includes the same information.

In support of its motion, Twin Diamond argued that disclosure of the material would have a reasonable likelihood of threatening the public safety by exposing a vulnerability in preventing, protecting against, mitigating, or responding to a terrorist act by disclosing water distribution infrastructure locations.¹

Having considered the motion and the material at issue, the Commission finds that specific location of the water distribution infrastructure is generally recognized as confidential or proprietary the disclosure of which would have a reasonable likelihood of

threatening the public safety;² it therefore meets the criteria for confidential treatment and should be exempted from public disclosure pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13, and KRS 61.878(1)(m)(1).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Twin Diamond's August 13, 2025 motion for confidential treatment is granted.

2. The designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order shall not be placed in the public record or made available for public inspection for indefinite period or until further order of this Commission.

3. Use of the designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order in any Commission proceeding shall comply with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13(9).

4. If the designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order becomes publicly available or no longer qualifies for confidential treatment, Twin Diamond shall inform the Commission and file with the Commission an unredacted copy of the designated material.

5. If a nonparty to this proceeding requests to inspect the material granted confidential treatment by this Order and the period during which the material has been granted confidential treatment has not expired, Twin Diamond shall have 20 days from receipt of written notice of the request to demonstrate that the material still falls within the exclusions from disclosure requirements established in KRS 61.878. If Twin Diamond is

unable to make such demonstration, the requested material shall be made available for inspection. Otherwise, the Commission shall deny the request for inspection.

6. The Commission shall not make the requested material available for inspection for 20 days from the date of service of an Order finding that the material no longer qualifies for confidential treatment in order to allow Twin Diamond to seek a remedy afforded by law.


