INTRA-AGENCY MEMORANDUM

RE: Informal Conference of October 31, 2024

Pursuant to an Order issued on October 25, 2024, an informal conference (IC) was conducted on October 31, 2024. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the IC was to allow Atmos Energy Corporation (Atmos) to summarize its general rate case application and provide a technical presentation on the financial schedules included with the application.

Atmos personnel stated that its revenue requirement was based on a forecasted test period using a base period of one year ending December 31, 2024. As reasons for filing for rate increase, Atmos cited a rate of return on rate base for the test year of 4.12 percent at current rates, accounting for excess deferred income tax, addressing capital expenditure requirements, and addressing cloud computing expense. Atmos pointed out its proposed tax and Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) rider tariffs and noted that its Pipeline Replacement Project (PRP) expenditures would not be rolled into general rates.

Atmos then summarized how it allocates expenses to Kentucky using its Cost Allocation Manual. Atmos stated that its corporate structure does not utilize separate affiliates for each state, so it allocates to Atmos Kentucky 100 percent of expenses used only for Kentucky operations and uses other allocation percentages for its regional (Kentucky/Mid-States) office and company-wide services.

Atmos then reviewed a spreadsheet containing its revenue requirement model,¹ including tabs for Summary Rate Base, Operating Income (Revenues & Expenses), Adjustments to Operating Income by Account, Income Tax Calculation, Rule F Compliance Adjustments, Payroll Analysis, Gross Revenue Conversion Factor, Comparative Income Statements, Cost of Capital, and Comparative Financial Data. Atmos reviewed each of these elements of the model, briefly discussing allocation, calculations, and supporting documents. Atmos then reviewed another spreadsheet,²

which included test year revenues, load forecast, and other information used to determine rate design.

There being no further discussion, the IC was then adjourned.
