ORDER

On September 13, 2024, Judy Water Association, Inc. (Judy Water) tendered an application requesting approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure set forth in KRS 278.012 and 807 KAR 5:068. On September 16, 2024, Judy Water was notified that its application was rejected for certain filing deficiencies. On September 17, 2024, Judy Water submitted further documentation to correct the filing deficiencies, and the application was deemed filed as of September 17, 2024.

LEGAL STANDARD

In accordance with KRS 278.012, when a wholesale supplier selling water to a water association increases its rates, the water association has the authority to increase its rate commensurate with the wholesale supplier. The water association must file, within the statutory and regulatory deadlines, a copy of the notice from the wholesale supplier showing the increase in the wholesale rate, and a statement of the volume of purchased water used to calculate the rate adjustment. The Commission shall approve the filing by order after the above documents are filed.

DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS

Judy Water purchases water from Kentucky-American Water Company (Kentucky-American) and Mt. Sterling Water and Sewer System (Mt. Sterling). Kentucky-American notified Judy Water that its wholesale rate would increase from \$4.52 per 1,000 gallons for the first 2,000,000 gallons and \$4.62 per 1,000 gallons for over 2,000,000 gallons to \$4.6912 per 1,000 gallons, effective February 6, 2024. Judy Water proposed to increase the water rates to its customers effective October 1, 2024, to reflect the increased cost of purchased water from Kentucky-American. A separate increase from Mt. Sterling in Case No. 2024-00258 was effective on September 10, 2024. Mt. Sterling proposed no further increases in rates.

Unaccounted-for Water Loss

Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 6(3), states that for ratemaking purposes a utility's unaccounted-for water loss shall not exceed 15 percent of the total water produced and purchased, excluding water consumed by a utility in its own operations. In its 2021 Annual Report filed with the Commission, Judy Water reported a water loss of 17.5225 percent.³ In its 2022 Annual Report filed with the Commission, Judy Water reported a water loss of 15.3375 percent.⁴ In its 2023 Annual Report filed

with the Commission, Judy Water reported a water loss of 13.1729 percent.⁵ Judy Water's three-year water loss average is 15.3443.⁶ The approximate cost of Judy Water's total water loss using a 3-year average is \$113,711.80.⁷

Financial Condition and Rates

Based on a review of Commission records, Judy Water last sought a general base rate adjustment in 2022. In Case No. 2022-00436,⁸ Judy Water's rates increased by \$247,351, or 20.31 percent, as of August 4, 2023. Prior to the increase, Judy Water's rate-based income (adjusted net income minus principal payments) was negative in all years except 2023, which reflected approximately four months of the rate increase. Cash basis income⁹ was positive for years 2019 through 2023. The Commission recommends Judy Water monitor its operating performance annually to determine whether a rate adjustment application should be submitted and that future rate cases be filed at least every three to five years depending on inflation and operating performance.

Purchased Water Adjustment Factor

In its application, Judy Water proposed a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.05 per 1,000 gallons. During the 12 months ended August 31, 2024, Judy Water purchased 39,715,200 gallons of water from Kentucky-American at \$4.52 per 1,000

gallons, and 10,495,300 from Kentucky-American at \$4.62 per 1,000 gallons.¹⁰ Judy Water also purchased 132,335,393 gallons of water from Mt. Sterling and sold 157,964,882 gallons of water to its customers. The increase in the cost of purchased water from Kentucky-American is \$7,546.51, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.05 per 1,000 gallons. No rate changes occurred from Mt. Sterling.

The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.05 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A and the rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are fair, just and reasonable and should be approved for water service rendered by Judy Water on and after October 1, 2024, because the rates are supported by evidence of the increase in rates from Judy Water's wholesale water supplier and the volume of purchased water used to calculate the rates in accordance with KRS 278.012.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.05 per 1,000 gallons is approved.
 - 2. The rates proposed by Judy Water are approved.
- 3. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are approved for water service rendered by Judy Water on and after October 1, 2024.
- 4. Within 20 days of the date of service of this Order, Judy Water shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
 - This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
