KENTUCKY-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY'S
STATEMENT REGARDING HEARING


Now comes the Defendant, Kentucky-American Water Company (“KAW”), and hereby provides this Statement Regarding Hearing. The Commission’s May 19, 2026 Order in this matter set a deadline of June 26, 2026 for “requests for a public hearing or to submit the matter for decision based upon the written record.”¹ KAW appreciates the opportunity to request a hearing and the Commission’s willingness to conduct one. However, KAW does not believe a hearing is necessary and requests that this matter be submitted on the written record. KAW believes the Commission has everything it needs to grant KAW’s May 22, 2025 Motion to Dismiss, including the attachments to that motion and KAW’s June 19, 2026 Responses to Staff’s First Request for Information. Those filings show that the meter in question tested accurately and that the elevated usage for the customer decreased significantly *before* the meter in question was replaced with a new meter. KAW also notes that, as of the filing of this statement, the Complainants have not responded to Commission Staff’s June 3, 2026 Request for

Information to them despite the fact that the deadline for filing those responses was June 19, 2026. Had Complainants responded, the Commission and KAW would know if Complainants performed any repairs to their water service line that correlate with the decrease in water usage since the meter in question (which tested accurately) was removed. Based on all of this, KAW believes that a decision can be reached on the existing record without the need for hearing. However, to the extent the Commission has any remaining questions or concerns that would prevent granting KAW's Motion to Dismiss, KAW would gladly appear at a hearing or an informal conference to address those questions or concerns.


