Good afternoon and thank you for the opportunity to speak via email.

I'm write this to express my deep concern regarding the proposed solar panel development on our local farmland.

We live in an area prone to extreme weather. Tornadoes and flooding are not rare events here—they're part of our reality. When storms strike, we must ask: what happens to those solar panels?
