#### <u>O R D E R</u>

On November 22, 2024,<sup>1</sup> Kentucky Power Company (Kentucky Power) filed an application for a Certification of Public Necessity (CPCN) to be issued on or before February 13, 2025, authorizing Kentucky Power to replace and upgrade portions of the Bellefonte Station in Boyd County, Kentucky. On November 21, 2024, Kentucky Power filed a motion for an informal conference (IC) in this matter.

The Commission finds that the motion for an IC should be granted. Kentucky Power requested a date of February 13, 2025 for a final Order, and the Commission agrees that one way to facilitate the utility's request is to allow for an informal conference to facilitate discussion on this application. In addition, the Commission, on its own motion, finds that a procedural schedule should be established for the orderly processing of this case. The procedural schedule is attached as an Appendix to this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Kentucky Power's motion for an IC is granted.

2. The IC shall be December 17, 2024, at 10 a.m. Eastern Standard Time. Commission Staff shall facilitate arrangements.

3. The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix to this Order shall be followed.

4. Kentucky Power shall respond to all requests for information propounded by Commission Staff, whether identified on the procedural schedule or otherwise, as provided in those requests.

5. Any party filing a paper with the Commission shall file an electronic copy in accordance with the electronic filing procedures set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked. The Commission directs the parties to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085<sup>2</sup> regarding filings with the Commission.

6. As set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(11)(a), a person requesting permissive intervention in a Commission proceeding is required to demonstrate either (1) a special interest in the proceeding that is not adequately represented in the case, or (2) that the person requesting permissive intervention is likely to present issues or develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings. Therefore, any person requesting to

intervene in a Commission proceeding must state with specificity the person's special interest that is not otherwise adequately represented, or the issues and facts that the person will present that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter. A mere recitation of the quantity of utility service consumed by the movant or a general statement regarding a potential impact of possible modification of rates will not be deemed sufficient to establish a special interest.

7. Any motion to intervene filed after the date established in the procedural schedule shall also show good cause for being untimely. If the untimely motion is granted, the movant shall accept and abide by the existing procedural schedule.

8. The Commission does not look favorably upon motions for continuance. Accordingly, motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.
