DATA REQUEST

- KPSC 3_1** Refer to Kentucky Power's response to Commission Staff's Second Request for Information (Staff's Second Request), Item 2, Confidential Attachment 1.
- a. Confirm if this is the only structure Kentucky Power identified at 1834 Rockhouse Rd., Phelps, KY 41553 (service address). If unable to confirm, explain.
 - b. State if Kentucky Power identified any other sources of electrical consumption at the service address and provide a description of those consumption sources.

RESPONSE

- a. In addition to the structure shown in the Company's response to Staff's Second Request, Item 2, Confidential Attachment 2, the Company also observed a pool on the property but does not have information as to whether the pool is functional.
- b. The Company has not identified any other sources of energy consumption at Ms. Hurley's residence. As discussed in response to KPSC 2_2, the Company completed a visual assessment of the exterior of Ms. Hurley's home. A customer service account manager spoke with Ms. Hurley in February; however, Ms. Hurley ended the call before the Company had an opportunity to inquire as to any sources of energy consumption. Additionally, the Company's DSM vendor, TRC, called and emailed Ms. Hurley on February 20, 2026, and then spoke with her on March 16, 2026, to offer a home energy assessment as part of the Home Energy Improvement Program. TRC has still not received the required application form needed to proceed with scheduling an assessment.

- a. Confirm if Kentucky Power has discussed the proposed payment arrangements with Ms. Hurley.
- b. If confirmed, explain any payment arrangements that have been made with Ms. Hurley.

RESPONSE

a. and b. As discussed in response to KPSC 1_6, Kentucky Power previously offered Ms. Hurley a payment arrangement, which she declined. Ms. Hurley refused this payment arrangement because the Company included amounts from October 2024 through January 2025 in the total payment amount. These amounts could not be excluded from the payment plan that the Company presented to Ms. Hurley because the Company's billing system cannot establish a payment arrangement that excludes portions of a bill. The Company has not attempted to make any further contact with Ms. Hurley in light of this proceeding.

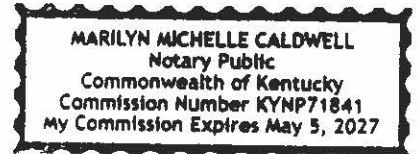
