ORDER

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission established this case on May 28, 2025, to review and evaluate the operation of the Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC) of Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E) for the six months that ended on April 30, 2024. As part of this review, LG&E responded to two requests for information.

A review of LG&E's monthly FAC filings shows that the fuel cost for the six months under review ranged from a low of \$0.02592 per kWh in November of 2023 to a high of \$0.03187 per kWh in January of 2024 with a six-month average of \$0.02777 per kWh.

Having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds no evidence of improper calculation or application of LG&E's FAC charges or improper fuel procurement practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- The charges and credits billed by LG&E through its FAC from November 1,
 2023, through April 30, 2024, are approved.
 - This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
