Comments: Ledbetter Water and Sewer still has rates posted on their website from prior to the 11/30/22 approval of rate change. https://ledbetterwater.com/rates/ Every month folks are on our town Facebook group posting ridiculously high bills from Ledbetter Water & Sewer, over \$100 and many over \$200. There have been numerous meetings about the high costs, and we are just told it's due to the loan servicing, etc. I've owned my home here since 2017. I only just learned the other day about the issue where they raised rates in 2021 without KPSC approval, which I discovered on your website. We weren't informed of any of this. Per an April 4, 2025 Public Notice, Ledbetter Water and Sewer District is not meeting its reporting obligations of KRS 65A.020 to the KY Department for Local Government. Three annual audits are missing, as well as numerous years' budget reports. This all seems like case of mismanagement, and should be investigated and their bookkeeping audited before they are allowed to raise rates again. So many folks struggle to pay these bills as it is, because they are high in cost. The residents need some transparency here to trust that these rates are fair and being calculated correctly, and

aren't being raised to cover for financial mismanagement.
