INITIATING ORDER FOR ALLEGED 811 VIOLATION OF THE KENTUCKY UNDERGROUND FACILITY DAMAGE PREVENTION ACT

(Se proporciona la traducción al español de este documento como anexo/apéndice B.)

Brimstone Utilities LLC (Brimstone Utilities) has been named as a party to an investigation before the Kentucky Public Service Commission (Commission) for allegedly violating the Kentucky Underground Facility Damage Prevention Act (Act). A hearing in this case shall take place on July 24, 2025.

Pursuant to KRS 278.495(2), the Commission has jurisdiction to regulate the safety of natural gas facilities in Kentucky and to enforce minimum federal pipeline safety standards. Under the Act, the Commission has authority to investigate and assess civil penalties for any violation of the Act that results in excavation damage to an underground facility used to transport natural gas or hazardous liquid subject to federal pipeline safety laws, 49 U.S.C. § 60101, et seq. Any person who violates any provision of the Act is subject to assessment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$250 for the first offense, no more than \$1,000 for the second offense within one year, and no more than \$3,000 for

the third and any subsequent offense. Additionally, any person whose violation of the Act results in damage to an underground facility containing any flammable, toxic, corrosive, or hazardous material or results in the release of any flammable, toxic, corrosive, or hazardous material is subject to an additional penalty of up to \$1,000.

Following receipt of a report of excavation damage to its underground gas pipeline from an operator, Commission Staff (Staff) conducted an investigation and prepared an Incident Report, a copy of which is attached to this Order as Appendix A. In its Incident Report, Staff cites Brimstone Utilities for violation of the following provision of the Act:

KRS 367.4911(10) – When excavation or demolition is necessary within the tolerance zone, the excavator shall hand-dig or use nonintrusive means to avoid damage to the underground facility, except that mechanized equipment may be used:

Based on its review of the Incident Report and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds prima facie evidence that Brimstone Utilities violated the Underground Facility Damage Prevention Act. The Commission further finds that a formal investigation into the excavation damage incident shall be conducted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Brimstone Utilities shall submit to the Commission, via email sent to PSCED@ky.gov with the case number of this proceeding in the subject line of the message, a written response to the allegations contained in the Staff Incident Report within 20 days of receipt of this Order.
- 2. Brimstone Utilities shall appear on July 24, 2025, at 9 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time, in the Richard Raff Hearing Room at the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Boulevard in Frankfort, Kentucky, for the purpose of presenting evidence concerning the alleged violation of the Underground Facility Damage Prevention Act.

- 3. The July 24, 2025 hearing shall be conducted via video conferencing.
- 4. Brimstone Utilities shall attend the hearing by using the following link:

- 5. Brimstone Utilities shall notify the Commission at least ten days prior to the hearing if Brimstone Utilities is unable to appear by video conferencing and will therefore appear in person.
- 6. Any partnership, corporation, or business entity (including a limited liability company) must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Kentucky, and such representation includes the filing of papers with and appearances at hearings before the Commission.
- 7. An individual may submit a response to the allegations contained in the Staff Incident Report without the representation of an attorney.
- 8. The Staff Incident Report 55497, attached to this Order as Appendix A, is made a part of the record in this case.
 - 9. The July 24, 2025 hearing shall be recorded by video only.
- 10. Please note parties who fail to appear after service will be subject to entry of a default judgment against them.



Tras recibir un informe de daños por excavación en su gasoducto subterráneo por parte de un operador, el personal de la Comisión (el Personal) llevó a cabo una investigación y preparó un Informe de Incidentes, cuya copia se adjunta a esta Orden como Apéndice A. En su Informe de Incidentes, el Personal cita a Brimstone Utilities por la infracción de la siguiente disposición de la Ley:

KRS 367.4911(10) - Cuando sea necesario excavar o demoler dentro de la ubicación aproximada de la instalación subterránea, el excavador deberá cavar a mano o utilizar medios no intrusivos para evitar daños a la instalación subterránea.

Basándose en su revisión del Informe de Incidentes y estando suficientemente informada, la Comisión encuentra pruebas prima facie de que Brimstone Utilities violo la Ley de Prevención de Daños a Instalaciones Subterráneas. La Comisión considera, además, que debe llevarse a cabo una investigación formal sobre el incidente de los daños causados por la excavación.

POR LO TANTO SE ORDENA que:

1. Brimstone Utilities deberá presentar a la Comisión una respuesta por escrito a las alegaciones contenidas en el Informe de Incidencia del Personal en un plazo de 20 días a partir de la recepción de esta Orden a través de un correo electrónico

del mensaje.
