Dear Public Service Commission,

I am writing to you with concerns about a proposed construction of a wireless cellular tower on a site located at 264 Hill Drive, Chavies, KY 41727. The concern is with how close this tower will be to our home. The cellular tower is referenced to docket number 2025-00180. I am concerned about possible health effects for my family and pets having a cell tower being so close to our home. Also there is a graveyard that people visit frequently that is directly adjacent to the proposed location of the cell tower. I and others in the community are concerned about health related issues and the effect on the graveyard appearances and the property value declines.

If there is nothing we can do about the cell tower being constructed, we would like to know what precautions are being taken to decrease the radiation exposure to the residents. There is a community of people directly in front of the selected cell tower site. For instance, the front of the antenna has the strongest radiation exposure. Could the front of the antenna be directed away from the homes? I know the antenna type and placement, and the height of the tower are two things that can reduce our radiation exposure. I have read where the cellular tower company can place devices at residents homes to measure the level of radiation they are receiving. We would like this at the homes closest to the towers. Most material I have read states a safe distance is at least 1320 feet, and our homes are probably less than 500 feet away from the proposed cellular tower site. I would appreciate any help addressing our concerns for safety for our home and our community.
