Pursuant to Kentucky Power Company's (Kentucky Power) motion filed June 17, 2026, and the Commission's Order entered June 24, 2026, an informal conference (IC) was conducted on June 25, 2026. This is the first IC held in this docket. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the informal conference was to discuss Kentucky Power's Motion for Rehearing filed June 17, 2026 in response the Commission's final Order in this case issued on May 28, 2026. During the conference, Kentucky Power provided an overview of issues raised in its rehearing motion. Kentucky Power reviewed the exhibit attached to the rehearing motion, discussed issues relating to accounting deferral processes, revenue and expense, securitization, and other relevant issues, and Staff was able to ask questions regarding such issues to the extent clarification was needed. Additionally, Kentucky Power discussed its billing software and potential technical issues with having a percent of revenue charge reference a percent of revenue charge and with adjusting bills for changes placed in effect subject to refund. Kentucky Power's representatives indicated that they would inquire as to the abilities of the software to carry out certain functions discussed in the IC.

There being no further material discussions, the IC was then adjourned.
