COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
TO KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY

Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) and Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E) (jointly, LG&E/KU), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on June 5, 2026. The Commission directs LG&E/KU to the Commission's July 22, 2021, Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the

response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

LG&E/KU shall make timely amendment to any prior response if LG&E/KU obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which LG&E/KU fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, LG&E/KU shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, LG&E/KU shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Refer to LG&E/KU's Mill Creek Unit 6- 60 day Project Update #1 (Project Update #1) at 1. Provide the Power Island Agreement for Mill Creek 6, once executed.
2. Refer to Project Update #1 at 1. Provide the request for proposal responses.
3. Refer to Project Update #1 at 2. Provide the signed contract with Siemens and the contract with HICO America for the Generation Step Up Transformers.

4. Refer to Project Update #1 at 3. Provide a copy of the Mill Creek 6 engineering, procurement, and construction (EPC) Agreement once executed, on or before June 1, 2026.

5. Refer to Project Update #1 at 4. Provide the reimbursement agreements.

6. Refer to Project Update #1 at 4. Explain whether LG&E/KU has changed the way they evaluate the economic development pipeline or the load forecast given the findings in Case No. 2025-00045².

7. Refer to Project Update #1 at 5. Provide a status update on the Global Laser Enrichment project.

8. Refer to Project Update #1, Attachment 2.

a. Provide the data used to create the chart shown in Attachment 2, in Excel spreadsheet format with all formulas, columns, and rows unprotected and fully accessible.

b. If available, provide an updated version of the chart in all future Project Updates throughout the processing of this monitoring case. Consider this an ongoing request.

c. If a Project Update shows cost variance of 10.0 percent or more from the estimated costs from Case No. 2025-00045, provide a brief, narrative description of the reason for the variance.
