ORDER

On June 6, 2024, Weirs Creek Solar, LLC (Weirs Creek Solar) submitted a \$160,000.00 application fee as required by KRS 278.706(5) and 807 KAR 5:100 Section 5.¹ The fee was acknowledged by letter from the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting (Siting Board) dated June 6, 2024. A final Order was issued on December 3, 2024.² On November 6, 2025, Weirs Creek Solar filed an application to bifurcate and partially transfer of the construction certificate related directly to that original application and grant of conditional construction certificate. As of April 13, 2026, the Siting Board had accrued an additional \$339.74 in case-related expenses.

KRS 278.706(5) provides, "If a majority of the members of the board find that an applicant's initial fees are insufficient to pay the board's expenses associated with the application, including the board's expenses associated with legal review thereof, the board shall assess a supplemental application fee to cover the additional expenses."

The Siting Board, therefore, finds that Weirs Creek Solar should pay an additional amount totaling \$339.74 as a supplemental fee for expenses already incurred.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Weirs Creek Solar is assessed a supplemental fee of \$339.74.
2. Weirs Creek Solar shall remit payment to the Siting Board within 15 days of the date of service of this Order.
3. The payment shall be a certified check or money order made payable to the Kentucky State Treasurer that is delivered or postmarked as mailed to the Office of General Counsel, Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Boulevard Frankfort, Kentucky 40601-8294, before the deadline.






