As the Chair of the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC), I also serve as the Chair of the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting (Siting Board). Therefore, it is my duty to inform you that, on December 11, 2025, the Siting Board received a Notice of Intent from MYSO, LLC requesting a certificate to construct an approximately 200-megawatt merchant solar electric generation facility in Graves County, Kentucky.

The five permanent members of the Siting Board are the Chairman, Vice Chairman, and Commissioner of the PSC; the Secretary of the Energy and Environment Cabinet (or her designee);¹ and the Secretary of the Economic Development Cabinet (or his designee).²

NOTICE OF INTENT

MYSO, LLC (“Applicant” or “Mayfield Solar”), hereby submits its Notice of Intent to file an application for a Certificate to Construct an approximately 200 megawatt (“MW”) merchant solar electric generating facility in Graves County, Kentucky (“Project”), pursuant to KRS 278.700, *et seq.*, 807 KAR 5:110, and other applicable law. In support of its Notice of intent, Applicant states as follows:

1. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2(2)(a), the name and address of the person who intends to file the application is MYSO, LLC, 13123 East Emerald Coast Parkway, Suite B# 158, Inlet Beach, Florida 32461. The Applicant’s telephone number is: (850) 460-0829 and its email address is: development@brightnightpower.com.

2. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2(2)(b), the proposed Project will be capable of generating approximately 200 MW of electricity from a solar array covering a total of approximately 1,500 acres. The Project will connect to a substation to be constructed onsite and contained entirely within the Project’s footprint.

3. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2(2)(c), the Project is located in unincorporated Graves County, Kentucky, near the City of Mayfield. The Project has a street

address of 1620 Baldree Road East, Boaz, Kentucky 42027. Its latitude-longitude coordinates are 36°53'27.6"N, 88°39'52.8"W. No portion of the Project is located within the boundaries of any municipality.

4. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2(2)(d), there is no planning or zoning commission with jurisdiction over the site.

5. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2(2)(e), there are no local setback requirements applicable to this site.

6. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2(2)(f) and KRS 278.704(4), Applicant will request a deviation from the setback requirements established in KRS 278.704(2).
