Hello,

I am writing in response to the Notice that my complaint against Taylor Co. RECC failed to establish a prima facie case.

I respectfully submit this letter to clarify the facts and provide additional information and witnesses supporting my claim.

Taylor Co. RECC is attempting to charge me for approximately three years of electrical service at my property located at 3000 Eastridge Cemetery Road, Casey Creek, Kentucky. I did not reside at that address during the time period for which I am being billed, nor did I knowingly receive electrical service there. My actual residence history during that time period is as follows.

- November 11, 2019 - March 2024: 6721 Speck Ridge
- March 2024 - ~~January~~<sup>May</sup> 15, 2025: 3851 Raikes Hill Rd.
- May 2025 - January 15, 2026: 6721 Speck Ridge
- January 15, 2026 Returned to 3000 Eastridge Cemetery until present

During the period from November 2019 through January 2026 my property at 3000 Eastridge Cemetery Rd. was not occupied. Multiple neighbors and local residents can attest that no one lived at that residence during that time. I am prepared to provide sworn statements.

Despite this, Taylor County RECC has made several serious allegations that I was stealing electricity. These allegations are False.

RECC representatives have also claimed that deputies from the Taylor County Sheriff's Office responded to my property and witnessed electricity theft. This statement is untrue. I have spoken with a deputy from Taylor Co. Sheriff's Office who can testify that no such call or investigation occurred on my residence related to electric theft.

Additionally, I have experienced the following issues in my dealings with Taylor co. RECC

- False accusations of Electric theft.
- Billing for service during a time when the residence was unoccupied.
- Distribution of my personal information to others without my consent.
- Refusal to reconnect electrical service.
- Statements made to others, including the Public Service Commission, portraying me as a drug addict criminal.
- Statements claiming my home was "unfit to live in," which were used to damage my credibility.

While my home may not be large one or ~~the~~ "Whitehouse" it is my property and its the only home I have. I believe I have been unfairly judged based on assumptions rather than facts.

I also attempted to contact P.S.C. by phone, left messages but did not receive a return call. I understand someone visited the property and took pictures, however I was never contacted to provide my side of the situation or explain the circumstances.

I respectfully request that the Commission reconsider my complaint and allow me the opportunity to provide sworn witness statements and additional documentation necessary to establish the facts. I believe that once the timeline of my residence and the witness testimony are reviewed, it will be clear that I am not responsible for the electrical usage being charged to me.

Once again I can provide statements from neighbors, other residents, and even Government workers. that I did not live at said address.

I'm very serious about this situation  
to let you know how serious I am.

I have spent roughly \$3,500 on  
equipment to provide electric in my home.

That's \$1,500 more than what they claim  
I owe them. If I owed them for  
the electric I would have already payed  
RELL but this is alot bigger than a  
\$1,800 electric bill. I can provide  
documentation on everything I've stated  
in this letter.

Thank you for your time and  
consideration. I respectfully ask that  
this matter be reviewed again in light  
of additional information provided.
