RE: Informal Conference of March 24, 2026

Pursuant to a Staff Notice issued on March 23, 2026, an informal conference was conducted on March 24, 2026. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the informal conference was to discuss matters related to deficiencies and issues found in the application tendered on March 11, 2026. Staff reviewed the deficiency letter with Apache Gas Transmission Company, Inc (Apache Gas), and answered questions. Related to 807 KAR Section 15 (2)(d)(2) and KRS 322.340, Apache Gas stated it will likely file a deviation. Apache Gas provided an overview of the project which included that there would be no material benefit to using 6 inch pipelines and that it would instead be using 3-inch; stated it plans to use its own labor, and will hire outside labor for boring equipment. Further, Apache Gas informed Staff that half of the identified unburied pipeline will be addressed in this application and the other half will require additional funding/future application. Apache Gas requested additional time from Staff to file a response to the deficiency letter, until April 3, 2026. Staff had no objections to the extended time due to the nature of the deviations.

There being no further discussion, the informal conference was then adjourned.
