INTRA-AGENCY MEMORANDUM

KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

RE: Informal Conference of May 15, 2026

Pursuant to Notice filed on May 15, 2026, an informal conference was held in this matter on May 14, 2026. A list of conference participants is attached.

The purpose of the informal conference was to discuss issues presented in this matter and Kentucky Frontier Gas, LLC's (Kentucky Frontier) intent of the filing. Specifically, whether Kentucky Frontier proposed to change to its Farm Tap GCA mechanism or were seeking to apply the standard GCA methodology.

At the conference, representatives of Kentucky Frontier discussed the history of its service to farm tap customers, its separate farm tap tariff, and the farm tap tariff's gas cost adjustment mechanism. It was noted that the farm tap tariff's gas cost adjustment mechanism differs from the GCR formula in its distribution tariff and that much of the gas supplied to farm tap customers is purchased by Kentucky Frontier pursuant to fixed price contracts, which affects the timing and frequency of necessary gas cost adjustments. Representatives of Kentucky Frontier discussed the incorporation of its farm tap customers into the GCR rate mechanism in its distribution tariff and the application of a unified GCR rate.

Commission Staff noted that invoices from Tackett & Sons Drilling Contractors, Inc, Slone Energy, LLC, and Nytis were included in Kentucky Frontier's filing. Kentucky Frontier representative indicated that invoices from these suppliers would be filed into the record.

There being no further discussion, the informal conference was then adjourned.
