RE: Rate for Farm and Home Service – Schedule 1 – Inclining Bloc (IB)

Dear Ms. Bridwell:

Enclosed, please find for filing, Inter-County Energy Cooperative Corporation's ("Inter-County Energy") proposed new tariff, Rate for Farm and Home Service – Schedule 1 – Inclining Block (IB) ("Inclining Block").

Inter-County Energy is proposing this tariff to align the cost-of-service to low usage members and promote efficient use of electricity. Inter-County has modeled its tariff after those of other East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC") distribution cooperatives.¹ The proposed tariff has a monthly facilities charge, which is the same as the current Rate for Farm and Home Service – Schedule 1, and members are charged an increasing energy charge based on kilowatt hours ("kWh") used per month. The initial block is usage under 300 kWh, the next block includes usage up to 500 kWh, and the final block is for usage over 500 kWh.

Inter-County is only proposing the Inclining Block tariff for members taking service under Rate for Farm and Home Service – Schedule 1 which have separate metered structures that are agricultural in nature, including; barns, dairy barns, gates, grain bins, silos, and water well/pumps. Inter-County Energy included a one-year commitment for this rate schedule to prevent rate switching and to allow a member to gage its usage over a year. Inter-County is proposing the Inclining Block tariff for these members because these are members that typically have lower usage and would therefore see the benefit of the lower energy charge as opposed to an average residential member.

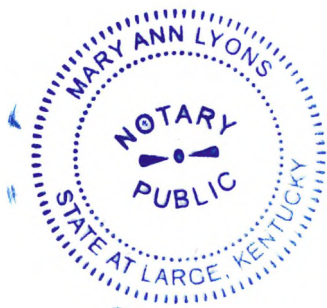

NOTICE

Inter-County Energy Cooperative Corporation ("Inter-County Energy") intends to propose a new tariff, Farm and Home Service - Schedule 1 - Inclining Block ("IB") by filing the new tariff with the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") on or after July 1, 2026. Inter-County Energy will request that the new tariff and the new rates associated with the new tariff become effective on or after August 1, 2026.

The new tariff will be a voluntary tariff for members currently served under Farm and Home Service - Rate Schedule 1 ("Schedule 1") that have low usage agricultural buildings; including, barns, dairy barn, garages, gates, grain bins, silos, and water wells/pumps. Members must agree to one-year minimum term to take service under this rate schedule.

Inter-County is only proposing the new tariff and the new rates associated with the new voluntary tariff. There are no existing rates and the proposed rates for the new tariff are set forth below:

Energy Charge per kWh	
0-300	\$0.07261
301-500	\$0.11057
Over 500	\$0.13778

Inter-County Energy does not propose revisions to any other tariffs or schedules not listed above.
