Dear Mr. Riggs:

The Public Service Commission has received the Petition for Confidential Treatment you filed on September 4, 2012 on behalf of T-Mobile Centrall LLC and PowerTel/Memphis, Inc. ("T-Mobile") to protect certain information filed with the Commission as confidential pursuant to Section 7 of 807 KAR 5:001 and KRS 61.878. The information you seek to have treated as confidential is identified as being contained in T-Mobile's Exhibits B, D and E of its Annual High Cost Universal Service Certification. The information is described as: (Exh. B) — estimate of capital and operating expenditures for 2013 in Kentucky ETC service area; (Exh. D) — complaints per 1,000 handsets report for 2011; and (Exh. E) — unfulfilled service requests report for 2011.

Your justification for having the Commission handle this material as confidential is that the public disclosure of the information could result in an unfair commercial advantage to competitors and would reveal trade secrets.

Based on a review of the information and pursuant to KRS 61.878 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7, the Commission has determined that the information requested to be held confidential is of a proprietary nature, which if publicly disclosed would permit an unfair commercial advantage to T-Mobile's competitors, and would reveal trade secrets. Therefore, the information requested to be treated as confidential **meets the criteria for confidential protection** and will be maintained as a nonpublic part of the Commission's file in this case. The procedure for usage of confidential materials during formal proceedings may be found at Section 7(8) of 807 KAR 5:001.
