AFFIDAVIT
Certification of Support for Eligible Telecommunications Carriers
Pursuit to 47 C.F.R. § 54.314

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared Harlon E. Parker of Ballard Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc., (“the Cooperative”), who on his oath deposed and said:

1. My name is Harlon E. Parker. I am employed by Ballard Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc. in the position of CEO/General Manager. In this capacity, I am personally familiar with the Federal Universal Service support received by the Cooperative and how these funds are used by the Cooperative.
2. Ballard Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc. was designated as an eligible telecommunications carrier by the Kentucky Public Service Commission in Administrative Case Number 360 by order dated November 26, 1997. Ballard Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc. provides service in study area 260396.
3. Pursuant to the requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 54.314, Ballard Rural Telephone Cooperative hereby certifies all federal high-cost support provided to the Cooperative was used in the preceding 2013 calendar year and will be used in the coming 2014 calendar year only for the provision, maintenance and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended, as designated by the Federal Communications Commission consistent with Section 254(e) of the federal Telecommunications Act. These funds will be used to provide the following supported services as outlined in 47 CFR § 54.101(a), which are available to any customer in the Cooperative’s service area: voice grade access to the public switched network or its functional equivalent; minutes of use for local service provided at no additional charge to end users; access to emergency services provided by local government or other public safety organizations, such as 911 and enhanced 911, to the extent the local government in an eligible carrier’s service area has implemented 911 or enhanced 911 systems; and toll limitation services to qualifying low income consumers.
4. Ballard Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc. follows Federal Communications Commission Part 32 accounting requirements for regulated local exchange carriers and Part 36 separations provisions used to determine high cost support amounts. As a regulated utility, Ballard Rural Telephone Cooperative’s accounting and separations procedures are subject to periodic National Exchange Carrier Association and Kentucky Public Service Commission reviews.

5. While continuing to receive Federal Universal Service support as described and using this support for the purposes as described, Ballard Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc. does not anticipate withdrawing any services; therefore, the comparability of service between the rural areas served by Ballard Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc. and the urban areas of Kentucky will not be changed because of any action on the part of Ballard Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc.
6. The matters addressed above are within my personal knowledge and are true and correct.
