Dear Mr. DeRouen:

Pursuant to the Commission's Order, dated January 22, 2007, in the aforementioned case, Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") hereby files a report of material changes that KU would have had to disclose to the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") on a Form 8-K if the company had continued to have publicly held secured debt. However, in connection with the recently issued First Mortgage Bonds, referenced below, KU anticipates filing registration statements with the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") during mid-2011. Upon such statements being declared effective by the SEC, KU would thereafter resume periodic SEC reporting, including Form 8-K's.

In compliance with this Commission order, KU is submitting this letter as its report. With respect to November 2010, KU believes it would have filed a Form 8-K for the following events:

- The official closing of the transfer of ownership of KU via the acquisition of E.ON US LLC by PPL Corporation
- Issuance of \$1.5 billion of First Mortgage Bonds
- Issuance of 21 promissory notes for \$1.331 billion to PPL Investment Corporation (which were repaid with proceeds of the First Mortgage Bonds listed above) to replace prior notes from Fidelia Corporation
- Entering into a multi-year revolving credit facility totaling \$400 million
- Entering into employment-related arrangements with KU management in connection with the PPL transaction
- Appointments to the KU board associated with the PPL transaction
