Farmers RECC Vegetation Management Plan for 2011

Here at Farmers RECC we are always committed to provide safe reliable service for our members. In 2011 we will continue our contracts with Environmental Consultants Inc. (ECI) and A & G Tree Service. ECI will continue to help manage our right-of way program in our second year cycle of right –of–way maintenance. This year we have prioritized nine circuits out of seven subs to be cleared by A & G Tree Service for a total of 631 miles of line clearing.

They are listed as follows:

Goodnight:	CKT 2
Munfordville:	CKT 2
Knob Lick:	CKT 4
Cave City:	CKT 1, CKT 2
J.B. Galloway:	CKT 2
Seymour:	CKT 2, CKT 4
Fox Hollow:	CKT 2

Currently A & G Tree Service has six circuit crews and two hourly crews to take care of the hot spots throughout the system.

In 2011 Farmers RECC has contracted a herbicide management program with Osmose. Currently, four subs and six circuits have been identified for this years' spray cycle, for a total of 543 miles.
